Wow!! Stan and Ryan Newkirk outdid themselves and put on a great tech night for the OTHG-SD. Paula and I made plans to get there early and arrived at about 5:10 pm. The parking lot was about two thirds full already. By the time the pizza arrived around 5:20 the parking lot was full and people were parking on both sides of the street.

After quickly consuming 10 or more of COSTCO’s pizza with cool soft drinks like root beer, orange crush, grape and they even had decaffeinated Cokes, Stan opened the presentation with a history of this third generation business which has always been in East County. After the introduction Stan’s son, Ryan, explained the 4 phases of their business. Ryan introduced their “super” employee Salvador as the hardest worker in the business. Ryan spoke about the radiators aluminum vs cooper, mechanical fans vs electric and A/C repairs. Ryan then explained when you want big exhaust vs small and then spent some time on headers. His last topic was the production work they do building specialty parts for different off road and motorcycle shops in the area. After some tech tips Stan and Ryan took questions for about a half hour. Prez Denise presented Stan and Ryan with our Tech Night plaque and by 7:30 the gang was starting to fold their chairs. Well not so fast, I left at 8:00 pm and at least 20 people were still asking questions.

At one time we had 78 people in attendance, 41 hot rods and some door slammers. Of the 78 total, 58 were members and the rest from the Street Masters, Coastal Cruisers and the Early Ford V-8 Club. Also at least 10 people who appeared to be friends of the Newkirks passed through for the presentation.
