TECH NIGHT NOVEMBER 14, 2013 CCC MOTORSPORTS

I was a little worried that the attendance would be down for our Tech night because at least 10 couples who normally attend were out of town. But OTHG, SD came through in a big way. Paula counted 52 people at one point and more came and left during the night. The Gang showed up with healthy appetites and consumed 8 ½ COSTCO pizzas out of 10. I did not count the cars, but the parking lot was full.

After pizza Greg Rentis, the lead mechanic for CCC MOTORSPORTS, was introduced and he explained what CCC MOTORSPORTS is all about. They do everything from oil changes to installation of computer controlled fuel injected crate engines. They were working on an LS powered dune buggy, a 50's Chevy pick-up with an early Corvette 427 engine and installing an LS engine in a Camaro.

After the introduction, Greg started the dyno pulls. We had 4 pulls, three had small block Chevys that ran around 200 hp. The BIG DOG of the night was Shirley Harrington's 41 Ford Fordor with a 351 Windsor. Bob rolled the Ford onto the dyno and Greg revved up the engine until it hit the power band and Ford just wanted more.
