O. T. H. G. MEETING
Minutes for November 5, 2014
Called to order: 7:00 PM by Denise Hume, President

Minutes: The reading of last months minutes waived, approved as is, **M/S/P**.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer, Sue Chambers read the treasurer's report.

M/S/P Treasurers report approved by the members in attendance.

New Members: None.

Correspondence/Car Club Council: No news from the CCC, everyone at the Sema Show. Jim Payne went over some of the future car shows.

Streak Report: Bill Hogue went over Streak 41 results and told the club that the general raffle only nets a little over \$1,000.00, after expenses, which was a lot of work and money spent for such a small return. Since the 90/10 rule applies to gross and not net the general raffle is a big loss. He mentioned that we should maybe think about not doing a general raffle and only having a grand raffle which nets a lot more money since a lot of the prizes are donated. After much discussion a vote was taken and the majority of the members voted to continue the general raffle. The 50/50 raffle will not be continued as the 90/10 rule applies to the gross. 90% of the Streak raffles totaled \$18,634.00 of that \$7,500.00 will go to Freedom Station, \$5,000.00 will go to San Diego Rescue Mission and \$6,134.00 will go back to OTHGSD to be used only for other charities or charitable purposes.

Medical Report: Jan Sawyer was feeling well enough to attend the meeting. So good to see her. Charlene Walsh fell off a ladder and broke her foot. Herb Stutivan (spelling), a former member, passed away November 4.

Old/New Business: Meeting opened with nominations for all the board positions. Suzie Chambers announced she would not be running for Treasurer this year. The following positions only had one nominee and the nominee's accepted their positions.

Denise Hume gave a brief explanation to the membership of the laws governing the raffle and how the raffle proceeds must be restricted to Charitable purposes.

Paula Pifer volunteered to look into the club funding scholarships at local schools and colleges. This could be a good use of some of the restricted funds from the Streak raffle.

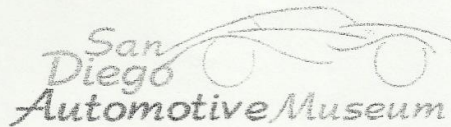
