**Minutes:** The reading of last months minutes waived, approved as is, **M/S/P.**  
**Treasurer's Report:** Treasurer, Sue Chambers read the treasurer's report. **M/S/P** Treasurers report approved by the members in attendance.

**New Members:** Welcome our returning member Paul Hayes. Paul was a member from 2000 – 2009 when he sold his car. He now is a proud owner of a 1956 Chrysler Windsor/Newport 2 door.

**Correspondence/Car Club Council:** Unfortunately I missed all of Jim Payne's presentation.

**Streak Report:** Bill was absent but sent news that the next meeting will be next Thursday, Jan. 10.

Denise Hume presented a check for \$5,000.00 to Herb Johnson of San Diego Rescue Mission. Herb expressed his gratitude and announced that OTHGSD has been honored by being included in the circle of 60 donor list which is part of the 60 year San Diego Rescue Missions Anniversary. Their mission is to raise funds for housing and build a school for the children.

**Medical Report:** Denise and Jack are both doing great. We have no current news about Jan Sawyer, praying she is doing better.

**New/Old Business:** Paula Pifer reviewed with the club members the following information she gathered on Cuyamaca College's Automotive Program:

**"I recently volunteered to get some information on the GM automotive program at Cuyamaca College so the club could consider giving scholarships to some of the automotive students. First I want to give you a little information about how I have been working with the Cuyamaca College automotive programs. I have been the chairperson of a scholarship committee with the EFV8 club since early 1997 that works on awarding scholarships to the Ford ASSET (Automotive Student Service Educational Training) students at Cuyamaca. Since 1997 the V8 club has given out a total of 51 scholarships totaling \$37,800. The Ford sponsored program is run much like the GM ASEP program (Automotive Service Educational Program) at Cuyamaca.**

**GM ASEP is a joint effort between GM, GM dealers, ACDelco and select colleges. At completion of the ASEP program the student will earn an Associate of Applied Science Degree in automotive technology. Having this degree enables them to advance in their career path. Graduates also receive credit toward GM or ACDelco certification which makes them even more valuable to their employer.**

## **Minutes for January 7, 2015 Continued....**

ASEP students will complete between 80 to 100 percent of the GM training required to become a GM certified technician and most of them will work to get ASE certified. (Automotive Service Excellence) Since the ASEP program started in 1979 it has produced over 15,000 automotive service technicians nationwide.

Most students will intern with a GM dealership who is interested in hiring them. During the two years at Cuyamaca College the ASEP student will alternate between the classroom and hands on experience from the sponsoring dealership. They work for the sponsoring employer for 8 weeks and then they return to college for 8 weeks of classroom study. Most of them gain employment with the sponsoring employer after graduation. There are currently 18 students in the Cuyamaca ASEP program, 13 are sponsored by either GM or an AC Delco service center. The other 5 students are employed by some other type of automotive business.

The average cost per student per year is approximately \$3,600 which includes tuition, fees and the cost of books. Students typically carry 15 units per semester and 6 additional units during the summer. In addition to this cost the automotive students usually try to buy some tools over the course of their two years in college which can easily add another \$2,000 to \$3,000 dollars to the total cost. This yearly cost does not include the expense of transportation, rent and personal expenses.

I believe we should award our scholarships to local students so the ASEP program would be a great way to accomplish this. Most of all, after these students graduate they will be able to get good paying jobs and will then become productive citizens of our community. This is something that we as a club could be very proud of.”

**M/S/P to support the scholarship program, Cuyamaca College Automotive Program.**
