There Has Been Some Confusion Concerning Life Members and annual dues. At the monthly meeting of April 7, 2010 the Life Member Bylaw 3.1.4 was discussed with the members in regards to Life Members paying annual dues and their voting rights. Ralph read to the club proposed changes that would require Life Members to continue to pay dues and have voting rights. A motion on these changes was made, seconded, and passed at this meeting. These changes were incorporated into the by-laws as of 04-07-2010. Below is the revised bylaw as approved by the members.

3.1.4. Life Member. Is an honor bestowed upon a Member who has been in the Club for 25 consecutive or nonconsecutive years that has been determined to be eligible by the Secretary. When an active member meets the criteria, the Secretary shall immediately confirm his/her findings to the President. The active member will receive special designation upon being designated a Life Member at the next Club meeting. The Life Member shall be awarded a bar at no cost to the member and will be titled "(year of recognition) Life Member".

This does not require a vote of the membership and becomes immediate when the criteria is met and confirmed. A Life Member is afforded the same voting rights as an Active Member.
