Most of you know that we have a county wide council that coordinates car shows throughout San Diego County. Did you know that it has been a positive factor in the car community for over 27 years.

I first attended the CCC as a representative for the Early Ford V-8 Club in 1995 or 96 and then became the Over The Hill Gang representative when Obie Oberlander became ill.

The purpose of the CCC as originally formed in 1985 was to coordinate car shows and car events in the county so they were not competing against other shows. This mission has expanded to all things that affect the car community especially new laws and regulations from all levels of government.

Presently we have around 70 car clubs as active members of the CCC. We also have "Associate Members" who represent business, swap meets and some government agencies.

All meetings are open to the public and held on the first Tuesday of the month on the second floor of the San Diego Auto Museum at 7:00 pm. The President of the CCC is Steve Lordigyan (you know him as Charger Steve of the Wednesday El Cajon car show). Steve was recently elected to replace OTHG member and long serving President Bob Schlotter.
