Streak Report: Bill Hogue thanked everyone for making the Streak a success again. 364 Streak registrations this year. Streak 44 raffle sales were \$23,600. Streak 43 raffle sales were \$20,500. 90% goes to charity or \$21,240. A question was raised about the 90/10 and Steve Cushman explained the law governing raffles and offered to send by email to any member the link to the Department of Justice (DOJ) web site that explains the 90/10 in detail.

The Streak has an additional \$10,000 in revenue to be considered by the members. The Streak committee to determine the charities and the amounts, it then will be brought before the members for a vote.
